Operation Strike Eagle 2012:

INTERNATIONAL AIRBORNE OPERATIONS® will run the next operation in this region as **"Operation Eagle 2012**" within the term July, 13th through 15th 2012!

During this operations we focus again onto the <u>mission oriented aspect</u> of a parachute jumps – we will jump with equipment bag and rifle. See also pictures of <u>Operation Strike Eagle 2010</u>.













We will jump for the following military parachutist wings of Czech Republic:



In case of 10 jumpers would like to gain the Slovakian Airborne wings, we will invite the respective jumpmaster:



Slovakian Army: Basic

Senior

Freefall

Requirements for the different levels for the respective wings on request!

Important: We jump for the wings authentically only! A sale of jump-wings without jump with the respective jump-master of the awarding nation will not take place at all!

Details to the jumps:

Operation Eagle 2012 is open to all experienced military static-line jumpers.

Drop-zone:	Airfield close to Pilsen/ Czech Republic
Jump-ship:	Biplane AN-2 (NATO Code Colt)
Training and briefing	 In English, Dutch and German language, executed by the Czech host unit On round-canopy system (i.e. automatically opening)
Parachute system:	Czech OVP-68/76A (steer-able military-round-canopy system)
Altitude:	round-canopy systems around 700m

Parachute beginner training:

Operation Eagle 2012 is open to parachute beginners. The beginner may choose, on which parachute system he would like to be trained - either round-canopy or square-canopy system.





Besides to the briefing in the parachute systems, jump-ships and DZ to all participants, novices in parachuting will receive an intensive training in exit-position, behaviour below the parachuting, mal-functions and parachute landing falls.

Please take in consideration that 90% of all Airborne units around the world are still jumping rounds by i.e. automatically opening. Our round-canopy course will open the door for you to join our world wide operations!

Requirements to participate in the jumps:

- A) Beginners must present on place:
- a) A medical certificate "fit for parachuting" (forms available on request) and participation in the medical check on place for 25,-€ during the course
- b) A third party (liability) insurance and foreign health insurance
- c) Physical Fitness
- d) Maximum body weight of 80kg
- B) Experienced jumpers must present on place on top to A:
- a) An Airborne training certificate or parachute logbook with appropriate entries
- b) Parachute logbook with appropriate entries of
 - A minimum number of 3 jumps with round-canopy system OVP-68 within the last 2years or
 - A minimum number of 5 jumps with other round-canopy systems
- c) At least 1 jump during the last 12 months
- d) Medical certifications:
 - International valid parachute licence (Dutch A-Licence will be accepted) or
 - Czech medical certificate not older than 2 years or
 - A medical certificate "fit for parachuting" (forms available on request) and participation in the medical check on place for 25,-€ during the œurse

e) Physical Fitness

Experienced jumpers who cannot meet the requirement b and c are requested to join the beginner training.

Every participant will also be asked to sign a liability waiver to the host unit and nation and organizer.

Important: All the above documents are checked on place. Those who may not meet the requirements will not participate in the jumps and receive no refund.

Operation Eagle 2012 includes:

Training and briefing	on round-canopy parachute systems (i.e. automatically opening)
No of jumps:	3 jumps in total - Beginners: 3 jump without equipment and rifle - Experienced jumpers: 2 without and 1 with equipment and rifle
Jump-wings:	Jump-wings of the Czech Armed Forces

How to come on the Czech airfield?

- A: You come by your own car. Directions will be provided after registration
- B: You fly into Prague International Airport. Transfers from Prague International Airport to the Czech Airfield and return can be provided on extra charge of 50,-€

Arrival: Beginners and experienced jumpers who participants in the Czech medical check: - On July, 12th 2012 by 6pm at Prague Airport or

- On July, 13th by 8am on the DZ

Experienced jumpers with international licence and valid Czech medical certificate:

- On July, 14th by 8.30am on the DZ

Departure: On July, 15th 2012 as off 6pm
